

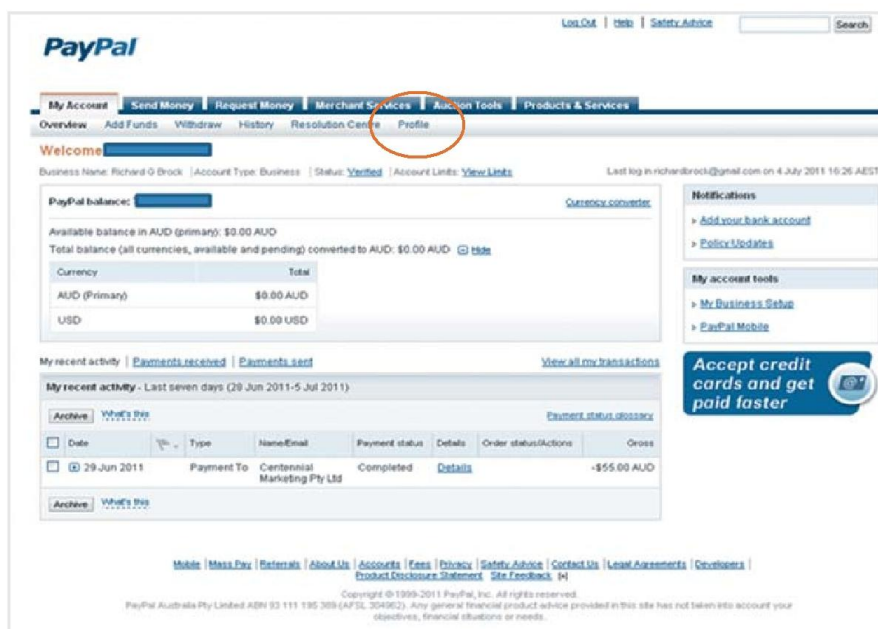
## Setup of API Access for PayPal Express Checkout

The following steps show you how to create and obtain your API credentials to enter into your shopping cart. This will link your shopping cart to your PayPal account. An API signature is a credential that consists of an API username along with an associated API password and signature, all of which are assigned by PayPal.

An API (Application Programming Interface) allows PayPal software to communicate with your online store or shopping cart.

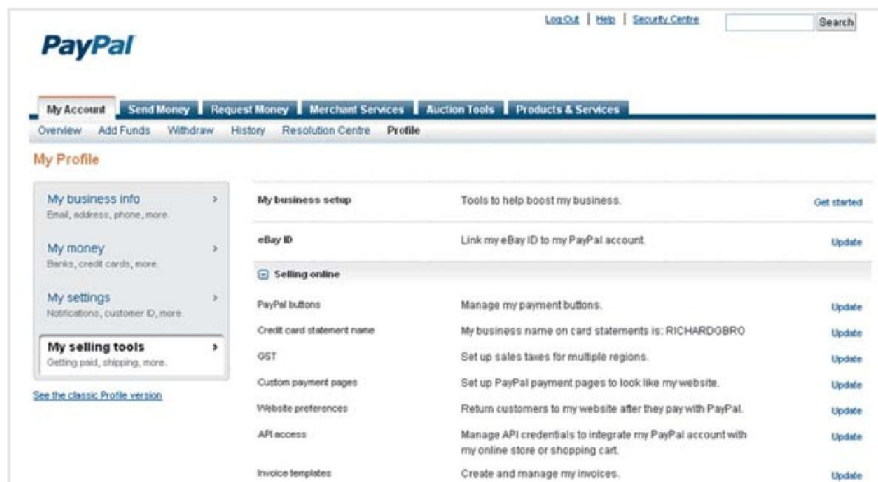
***You must have a PayPal business account.***

**1** Log in to your PayPal account and click the Profile subtab within MyAccount



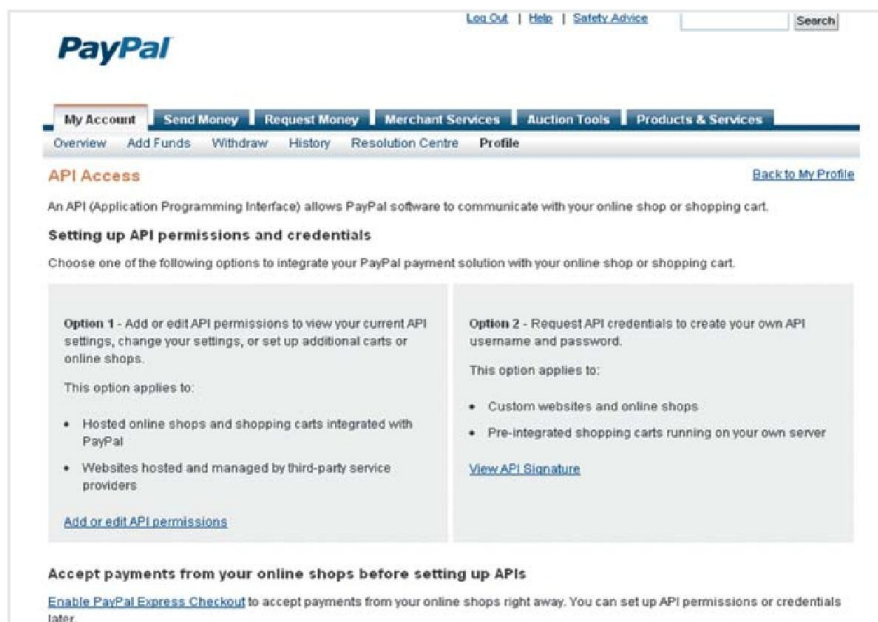

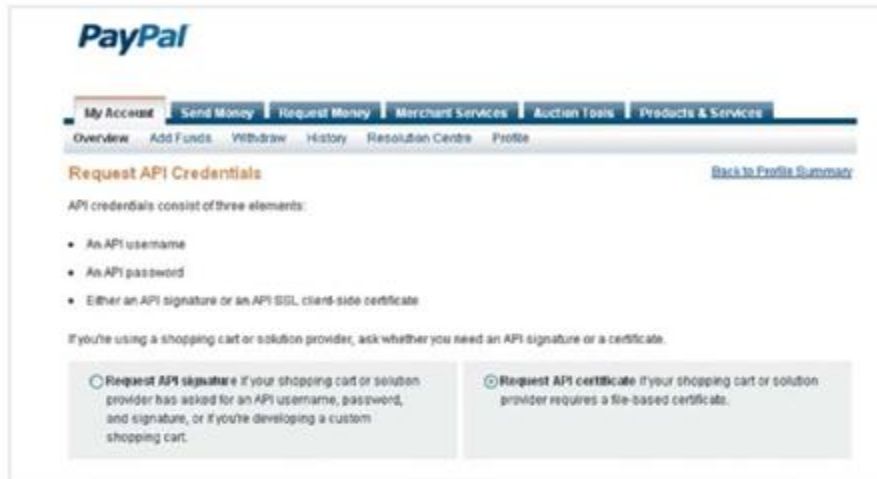
## 3 Click on [update](#) on the API access option
